#### CROSS-ADVOCACY COLLABORATION

- Housing
  - Green Social Housing resolution being considered (CM Siegel)
  - Initiatives to integrate small retail/commercial with housing
- Mobility
  - Initiatives on walkable communities / TODs (with services)
  - Street shade (trees) & I-35 support

#### ONGOING

- Identify Water Forward / One Water items to support
  - Water Forward cycle begins end of 2027, aligns with state water plan cycle
  - Dual plumbing, purple pipe
  - Incentivize GSI: swales and berms for infiltration
  - Propose funding mechanisms for affordable projects
  - Model on passive house affordable incentive program in 2025
  - San Marcos best practices: low cost natural infrastructure
- Mini conference: Water + AEC
  - Push needle on issue education, prioritization, and action
  - How to use the allocated AIA budget - bring in speakers etc.
  - Target: Fall/Winter
